Call for Nominations 'CHARLES V European Award' 2010

The European Academy of Yuste Foundation created the 'Charles V European award' in order to reward the work of those persons who, through their effort and dedication, have contributed to the general knowledge and enhancement of Europe's cultural, social, scientific, and historical values, as well as to the process of European integration.

The 'CHARLES V EUROPEAN AWARD' evokes Charles V's resignation of his powers, retiring to the Royal Monastery of Yuste, where he spent his last two years of life. The 'CHARLES V EUROPEAN AWARD' will be granted by the Board of Trustees of the European Academy of Yuste Foundation at the proposal of a jury appointed by the Foundation to that end.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The European Academy of Yuste Foundation will grant the 'CHARLES V EUROPEAN AWARD' 2010, according to the following terms and conditions:

FIRST

The European Academy of Yuste Foundation, in accordance with its founding principles, makes public the call for nominations for the ‘CHARLES V EUROPEAN AWARD’ 2010, whose aim is to reward those persons who, through their effort and dedication, have contributed to a ‘better knowledge and dissemination of the cultural and historical values of Europe, and/or to the unification of the European Union’.

SECOND

The ‘CHARLES V EUROPEAN AWARD’ 2010 will be granted by the Board of Trustees of the European Academy of Yuste Foundation, following the proposal made by a Jury appointed by the Board of Trustees, and composed of well-known figures in the fields of Science, Culture, History, Politics, *inter alia*.

THIRD

Candidates to the ‘CHARLES V EUROPEAN AWARD’ 2010, who should be nationals of any European country, may be nominated by any European institution, public entity, university, or cultural, scientific or socio-economic body. All nominations will require previous acceptance of the Award on the part of the candidate.

Candidates who request the award for themselves will be excluded.

Proposals will be formalized by submitting the official proposal form, duly filled in, or by sending the European Academy of Yuste Foundation a detailed supporting report, including, among other documents supporting the candidacy, a Curriculum Vitae of the candidate to the 'CHARLES V EUROPEAN AWARD' 2010.

Any documents adding important information or valuable support to the candidacy may be enclosed to the proposal.

FOURTH

The documentation may be submitted between the day after the publication of the present call for nominations in the Official Journal of Extremadura and the 30th of November 2009, either by registered mail or personally delivering it at the European Academy of Yuste Foundation's head office during opening office hours:

The deadline for proposal submission is 30th of November, the postmark being a valid proof of postage for those candidacies sent by mail.

FIFTH

The 'CHARLES V EUROPEAN AWARD' 2010 cannot be awarded posthumously.

The candidacies not fulfilling the above-mentioned requirements will not be accepted.

The documentation submitted will not be returned in any case; no correspondence will be held upon it either.

The 'CHARLES V EUROPEAN AWARD' 2010 will be granted to one only candidate according to the majority of the votes of the Jury. In case of tie, the vote of the president will decide.

SIXTH

The 'CHARLES V EUROPEAN AWARD' 2010 will be awarded during a formal ceremony in the Royal Monastery of Yuste.

SEVENTH

The 'CHARLES V EUROPEAN AWARD' 2010 is worth NINETY THOUSAND EURO.

EIGHTH

The European Academy of Yuste Foundation will officially announce, during the formal ceremony of the 'CHARLES V EUROPEAN AWARD' 2010, which will take place in the Royal Monastery of Yuste, the Call for European Research and Mobility Grants for
